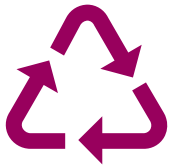

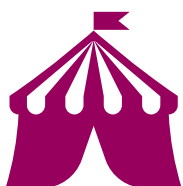

## Things To Do

Spending time outdoors or participating in recreation opportunities is important for your mind and body. Here's a list of our top five activities we think you should explore!

- 1) **Explore Big Bay** – Enjoy four acres of gardens, a nature trail, an arboretum, and Keppel Henge at the award-winning Keppel Croft Gardens in Big Bay. Take in the breathtaking views of Georgian Bay. And of course, practice your stone skipping skills at the Big Bay Boat Launch and Dock, Big Bay is the Stone Skipping Capital of Canada!
- 2) **Grey Roots Museum and Archives** – Grey Roots engages and educates residents and visitors in the history of Grey County by preserving and sharing collections, stories and memories. Grey Roots hosts exhibits, programs and events for all ages.
- 3) **Self-Guided Waterfall Tour** – Embark on a self-guided waterfall tour in the Township of Georgian Bluffs. The three famous falls, Jones Falls – Pottawatomi Conservation Area, Indian Falls Conservation Area, and Inglis Falls Conservation Area are each unique in their waterfall views, hiking opportunities and history.
- 4) **Bruce Caves Conservation Area** – Bruce Caves boasts unique cave formations found along the Niagara Escarpment. The caves were formed by the wave action of post-glacial Lake Algonquin, 7, 000 to 8, 000 years ago. Exploring Bruce Caves is an experience, add it to your list and learn more about the significant history this space brings to the Township.



- 5) **Hike the Bluffs** - Georgian Bluffs residents and visitors are spoiled for choice when it comes to hiking. The Bruce Trail and Georgian Bluffs Trail both wind through the Township. There are many outdoor spaces offering quiet places to hike and appreciate nature. If you're searching for that photo op, visit Skinner's Bluff Conservation Area and hike the Bruce Trail to be treated to a spectacular view. Georgian Bluffs is a four-season playground, be sure to check for notices or closures before visiting.

## About Grey Bruce Local Immigration Partnership

Our partnership spans across county lines, and community signs. Our coordination runs along sandy shorelines and flows over rolling fields. It reaches deep into Lake Huron and scales the Niagara Escarpment.

Collectively, we strive to build stronger communities through awareness, outreach, inclusion, and equity to ensure immigrants and newcomers become welcome neighbours throughout Grey and Bruce Counties. The Grey Bruce Local Immigration Partnership works in collaboration with service-based organizations to ensure that new residents thrive and enhance the vibrant, diverse, and colourful landscapes they now call home.



## Coordinating, Collaborating, and Connecting

How do we build a more welcoming and inclusive Grey / Bruce?

How can we work together to make it easier for newcomers to settle here?

*These questions are at the heart of the Grey Bruce Local Immigration Partnership (GBLIP).*

The GBLIP recognizes that immigration will continue to play a key role in the economic future of Grey and Bruce Counties. To support better immigration outcomes, the Partnership administers the GBLIP – a collaborative, community initiative designed to improve the integration of newcomers in Grey Bruce. Launched in June 2020, the GBLIP works at the local level to foster a community that is welcoming and inclusive and to support newcomers in becoming fully engaged in the social, economic, political, and cultural life of Grey and Bruce Counties.

### This is achieved through focus on four priority areas:

- 1) Improving the coordination of settlement and integration services
- 2) Raising awareness around the needs of newcomers
- 3) Supporting community-level research and planning
- 4) Fostering welcoming communities.

The GBLIP is one of the many **Local Immigration Partnerships (LIPs)** sponsored by **Immigration, Refugees, and Citizenship Canada (IRCC)**. This federal initiative addresses the growing need for systematic community planning around immigrant attraction and retention.

## **LIPs are underpinned by the understanding that:**

- Newcomers play an important role in the Canadian economy and society
- In the near future, some industries and regions will depend on immigration to fulfill their labour needs
- Municipalities and community groups are best positioned to improve settlement and integration outcomes for newcomers
- The provision of basic settlement services is not sufficient to ensure success – consideration of newcomer needs must be incorporated into all aspects of community planning.

## **Settlement Strategy**

The GBLIP Settlement Strategy 2025 is the culmination of more than a year of research and consultation, including 8 focus groups involving 62 participants across Grey Bruce and extensive surveys of both immigrants and the community at large.

The Settlement Strategy acts as the guiding document for the work of the GBLIP – providing a road map for how to build more welcoming and inclusive communities in Grey Bruce and improve the integration outcomes of newcomers.

## **It includes four strategic priorities:**

- 1) Build Capacity
- 2) Strengthen Community
- 3) Cultivate Prosperity
- 4) Foster Inclusion
