Volunteer Firefighter Recruitment

The Inter-Township Fire Department is currently recruiting for Volunteer Firefighters. The Inter-Township Fire Department serves the Township of Georgian Bluffs and Sydenham Township in the Municipality of Meaford. The Department is comprised of one (1) Fire Chief, one (1) Deputy Fire Chief and 41 Volunteer members.

Duties of a Volunteer Firefighter

As a Volunteer Firefighter you will be responsible for combating and extinguishing fires; prevention of fires; protection of person and properties; performing rescue work; administering emergency medical aid; and operating and maintaining firefighting apparatus and equipment, including maintenance of the fire station.

Volunteer Firefighters also participate in local public education events, attend regular scheduled training sessions, and contribute to enhance the safety and quality of life for those in the Township of Georgian Bluffs and Sydenham Township in the Municipality of Meaford.

Application Requirements

- Be 18 years of age and legally entitled to work in Canada.
- Reside in the Township of Georgian Bluffs, Sydenham Township in the Municipality of Meaford or the City of Owen Sound.
- Possess a Grade 12 diploma.
- Hold and maintain a valid, unrestricted Ontario Driver's Licence Class "D" with a "Z" endorsement (or obtain within the first year upon hire) and provide a clean drivers abstract.
- Hold a valid Standard First Aid and Level 'C' AED certificate.
- An ideal candidate will have NFPA 1001 Firefighter Level 1 and Firefighter Level 2
- NFPA 1002 Pumper Operations, would be an asset.

Firefighting is a strenuous job, performed in hostile environments in extremely stressful situations. It is important that potential volunteers be capable of handle these stresses, both physically and mentally.
