### Township of Georgian Bluffs By-Law Complaints

In the event of excessive noise or nuisance, a complaint could be launched against you during your stay.

The Township has a 24/7 hotline to address any issues or complaints related to short term accommodations. Here's how it works:

- 1. First Notification: If there's a complaint, the operator or their designate will be notified first and have one hour to address the issue with renters.

  2. Escalation: If the issue isn't resolved within the hour, it will be escalated to by-law enforcement.

This system helps address community concerns quickly, allowing you to resolve minor issues before they become formal complaints.
